ABOUT THE CENTER


Opened in December 2024, SOAR's SOLENA Center (Gyumri, Armenia) is a non-residential center that provides services to families with special needs children: employment/professional, substance abuse counseling, and job training for parents/caregivers and academic tutoring, nutritious meals, and psychological counseling for the children.

SOLENA offers a continuum of care and integration within the community to empower families and avert institutionalization.

Aim:


- Foster children's love for nature through direct interaction with the environment

Aim:


- Develop participants' creativity through the basics of candle-making techniques and materials




